

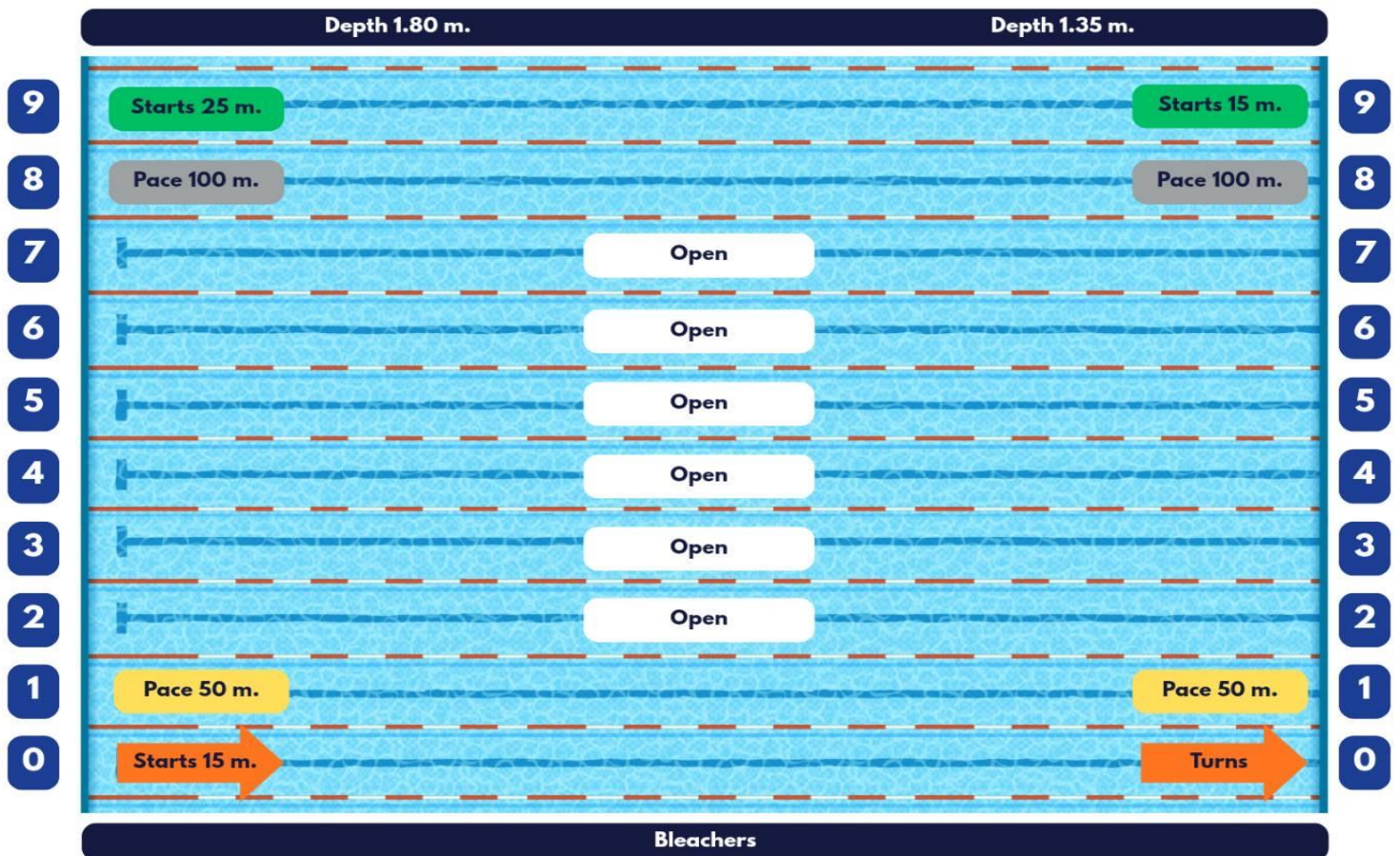


King's College International School Bangkok is delighted to welcome you to the King's Bangkok Swimming Cup, taking place at our Aquatics Centre this Friday through Sunday.

Please find the meet details below:

We will be running four warm-up sessions as outlined. All warm ups will be open warm ups. Teams are encouraged to use the designated lanes for starts, turns, pace work, and other specific preparations.

When swimmers need to exit the pool, please be mindful of other swimmers, and kindly remind swimmers not to sit on the lane ropes during warm up.



Meet Information – Friday PM

Arrival: 4:00 pm (Please do not arrive too early, as parking and traffic will be very busy.)

Warm-up: 4:15 pm – 5:15 pm

Session Starts: 5:30 pm

Coach Meeting: There will be no coach meeting on Friday.

Seating: All swimmers and visitors will be seated on the bleachers inside the swimming pool area.

Arrival: 6:45–7:15 AM

Warm-up: 7:15–8:15 AM

Coaches' Meeting: 8:00 AM

Resting Areas For Teams And Spectators

The teams will have allocated zones in the sports hall on Saturday and Sunday. Spectators are allowed at this event and will be seated in the bleachers to watch the races. We would ask that the swimmers bring their own mats to relax between races. Please do not wear high heels in the sports hall. Please see the Jotform link for details on the seating area.

Rules/ regulations

- World Aquatics rules will apply, however. A false start will result in a DQ, and the race will continue.
- Protests can be submitted by a team coach. No parent should communicate with the officials or host staff.
- There will be a 30-minute time limit on protests, as per World Aquatics rules.
- Electronic timing will be used.
- TSA referees
- We have dive blocks at both sides of the pool, and our pool meets FINA standards.
- Swimmers are not permitted on the bleachers during the Saturday and Sunday sessions

Parking
