Dear Coaches,

We are delighted to invite your school to join us for this year's TigerSharks Summer Sizzler meet. What acts as our end of year meet for all age groups, this is an opportunity for all competing swimmers to improve on their best times before the season break.

Students are challenged to hit medal target times dictated by World Aquatics point scores. This is a different challenge to the typical format of focusing on final positions and encourages swimmers to focus on their own performance as opposed to the performances of others as well.

To create a different yet still exciting format, all swimmers will be invited to compete in long course meter events on Saturday 6th June, this will be licensed and therefore a national qualifier. Followed by all swimmers being invited to compete in short course meter events on Sunday 7th June.

As an end of year meet and to accommodate as many swimmers as possible, sprint events will be the focus of the competition with some middle-distance events offered to both junior and senior age groups.

Vendors will be between both pools selling a selection of food and beverage also. There will also be some retail vendors on both days selling various products.

Meet Format

- The meet will be run with TSA officials on both days.
- This will be a TAA licensed meet for **Saturday 6th June ONLY** and can be used to qualify for national events. On Sunday 7th June this will not be TAA licensed.
- All events will run under normal World Aquatics rules.

Age Groups

- Junior Age Groups – 7 Years, 8 Years, 9 Years, 10 Years
- Senior Age Groups – 11/12 Years, 13/14 Years, 15/O Years.
- Age will be determined as of Saturday 6th June 2026.

Awards

- Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to those who achieve the target World Aquatics point score time of their respective age group and gender:

| Age Group | Gold | Silver | Bronze |

| 7 Years | 100 | 75 | 50 |
| 8 Years | 150 | 100 | 75 |
| 9 Years | 200 | 150 | 100 |
| 10 Years | 250 | 200 | 150 |
| 11/12 Years | 400 | 350 | 300 |
| 13/14 Years | 450 | 400 | 350 |
| 15/O Years | 500 | 450 | 400 |

*Note World Aquatics point times have been calculated from the World Aquatic points table.

Meet Fees and Withdrawal Deadlines

- The fee for all swimmers is 1,200THB.
- Invoices will be shared with schools on Tuesday 2nd June 2026. Swimmers who withdraw after this date will be fully charged.

Lunch and Vendors

- Lunch coupons will be provided on both days for swimmers. This will be a freshly cooked meal. Both meat and vegetarian options will be available.
- Food and beverage vendors will also be on campus throughout the weekend.
